# A Word from the Exhibition Chairman

Our club, the Ohio Stereo Photographic Society (OSPS) recently hosted the second OHIO PSA International Stereo Exhibition. The selection was held on April 8th, 2003. The Selection team included: Selectors: **John Waldsmith, Chuck Weiss, Dennis Petti**. Score Keeper: **Ron Fross**. Host: **Joe Hamblin**.

Everything went smoothly as the selectors scored 212 slides from 53 entrants. The scoring range was from 5 to 9 for each judge (15 to 27 total range). We were able to draw the line at 22, accepting 95 slides in our Exhibition. We only needed a brief rescoring to eliminate some of the 24s for the Honorable Mentions.

Again this year the quality of entries was quite high. One advantage of our judges this year is that, even though they have experience judging in our stereo club, they are not familiar with the slides that circulate in PSA. So these slides still maintained the element of impact/surprise for our judges.

I was pleased that several exhibitors were able to attend the first showing of this Exhibition in our May NSA Regional Meeting, on May 3rd. I was especially happy to personally present awards to **Dennis Hanser** (Gold Medal, Judge's Choice) and **Joe Hohmann** (Judge's Choice, 3 HMs).

This year, for the first time, we are awarding special medals for the Judge's Choice's and Best OSPS Entry. A pair of these medals are pictured in the front cover of this catalog. These medals bear the OSPS logo and, as far as I know, they are the first true stereoscopic medals. This means that there are two versions of the medal, the right and left side. The pair of medals can be freeviewed as a stereoscopic pair. The challenge for the exhibitors would be to win two medals and thus have the complete pair.

My personal thanks go to **Joe Hamblin** for hosting the selection and for Joe and **Dennis Petti** for helping with the sound of the final program. Also, many thanks the selectors and score keeper and to all who supported this Exhibition by entering their best stereo slides. We hope to see your entries again next year!

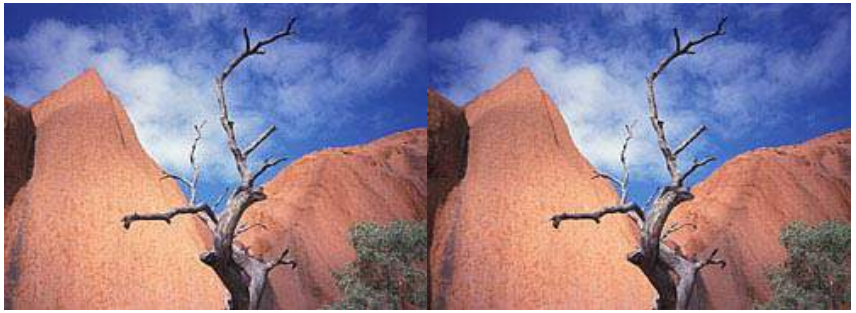

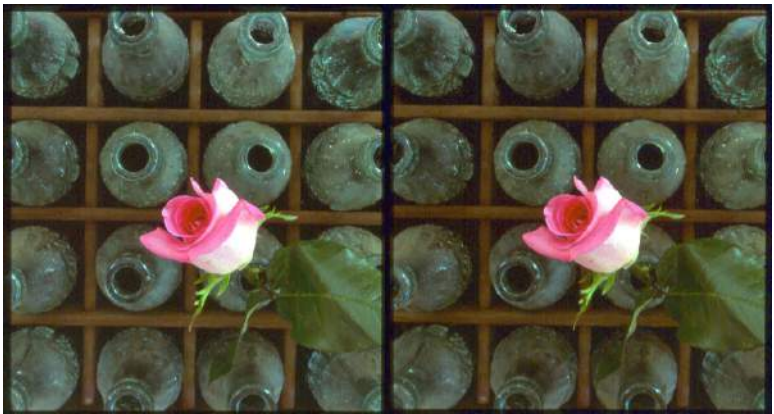
